Dear Seashore Members,

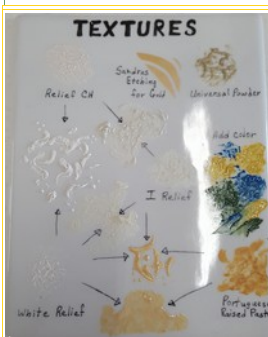
